



## Dr. Paul Turinsky Honored with the American Nuclear Society's Presidential Citation Award

Dr. Paul J. Turinsky, professor of nuclear engineering at North Carolina State University, received the American Nuclear Society's (ANS) Presidential Citation in Atlanta, Georgia this June 2009. Dr. William Burchill, then ANS president, did the honors.

Turinsky was honored “(f)or five years of dedicated service as a Commissioner on the Engineering Accreditation Commission (EAC) of ABET, Inc. To further the public welfare, Dr.

Turinsky's efforts as a Commissioner and also as a program evaluator helped ensure quality through the accreditation of educational programs, thereby assuring the competence of nuclear engineering graduates entering professional practice. His commitment and tireless efforts to assist the ANS with its efforts toward continuous improvement of nuclear engineering and technology education is appreciated.”

Turinsky received both his M.S.E. and Ph.D. in nuclear engineering from the University of Michigan in 1967 and 1970, respectively.
