

Graduate Degree Application Documents to be uploaded –

- **Transcripts:** Upload official college transcripts. Unofficial transcripts can be initially uploaded for review. However, upon admission, official transcripts must be provided to the Graduate School.
- **GRE (required for on-campus programs only):** Scores must be sent electronically from [ETS](#). The NC State institution code is 5496; there is no need for a departmental code. No minimum score is set for the GRE, do your best. The General GRE test scores expire five years after the test date. Expired scores will not be accepted.
- **TOEFL:** All international applicants, regardless of citizenship, must demonstrate proficiency in English at a level necessary to be successful in a graduate program at NC State. Additional TOEFL information is available [here](#), including a list of countries where English is the official language of higher education, exempting students from the test.
- **Personal Statement of Purpose:** A statement about your desired academic interest, possible research area(s), and future career goals is required. Potential [faculty](#) you would like to work with should be included in this statement (exclude Dr. Gilligan, Mr. Lassell, Dr. Wehring & Mr. Wicks).
- **Resume/CV**
- **Three letters of recommendations:** On your online application, list the name and email address for EACH referee. They will be notified by email message with a link to respond. Paper recommendations will not be considered.
